

Request for Quotes (RFQ): SXD Lab Prototype Development (PeerUp App)

Opportunity

eCampusOntario is seeking quotes from qualified individuals or agencies to develop and bring an iOS/Android app to a minimum viable product. PeerUp is primarily a chat tool that creates a safe space for students to connect with other peers and/or mentors. The goal with PeerUp is to develop a tool where students can comfortably ask questions, overcome barriers, demystify post-secondary education/career paths and make social connections to their learning communities that they would be unable to make themselves. All developed assets (excluding the user data) will become openly-licensed under a Creative Commons license. Where applicable, the successful vendor will use communications tools as specified by eCampusOntario.

Background

eCampusOntario operates the <u>Student Experience Design (SXD) Lab</u>, an Ontario innovation hub that uses human-centered design processes and tools to (re)design better student experiences. In 2017, a team of students designed the PeerUp prototype, which is a conversation focused application that addresses a key design problem.

The goal of the eCampusOntario SXD Lab is to produce student-led products, services and/or experiences that students can access to support and/or improve their learning experience.

Service Description

The successful app developer will provide the following support and services:

- Work in collaboration with students to bring the PeerUp app to a mimimum viable product, according to the following design: https://marvelapp.com/7793gf8.
- Work in collaboration with students and eCampusOntario to resolve issues and determine changes as necessary.
- Provide technical expertise to students and eCampusOntario where applicable.



Requirements for the Quote

- A proposed technical approach and cost
- Proven ability to design and develop apps with iOS and Android
- Suggested strategy for data hosting and management

Timeline

We expect the work to commece October 22, 2018 and be completed by March 1, 2018.

- 1. October 15: Request for Quote applications due
- 2. October 19: Contract awarded
- 3. October 22: Introductory meeting with student team and eCampusOntario
- 4. March 1: PeerUp MVP built

Applications

Providers should submit a one to three (1-3) page response to this request for quote, outlining a plan to complete the work within the timeframe and a detailed quote for services. Capabilities and credentials of the proposed team should be clearly stated along with relevant experience that would support the required activities.

Evaluation Criteria

Quotes will be evaluated based on the following criteria, with each item weighted equally:

- Proposed technical method for developing the application
- Proposed technical approach for hosting app data
- Experience with building apps
- Analysis of proposal costs
