

Design Intern

eCampusOntario is seeking an enthusiastic intern to support and advance the creation of experiential learning templates for the eCampusOntario Student Experience Design (SXD) Lab. The successful candidate will be a self-starter and a team player with a high tolerance for ambiguity in the workplace.

The ideal candidate will provide design expertise and project management support to:

- a) conceptualize and build student-led open templates for experiential learning in Fall 2019;
- b) help with tackling the high-level problem of *how might we* assist institutions scale experiential learning with technology.

eCampusOntario's SXD Lab is a hub supporting student-led innovation in an online and technology-enabled learning environment. The lab acts as a platform for students to build and prototype new methods, ideas, and/or products with the goal of making online and technology-enabled teaching and learning in Ontario even better.

What is eCampusOntario?

A not-for-profit corporation, eCampusOntario is funded by the Government of Ontario to be a Centre of Excellence for Online and Technology-Enabled Teaching and Learning for a membership composed of all 45-public colleges and universities in Ontario.

Position: Full-time, four-month contract with possibility of extension to March 2020.

Location: Downtown Toronto.

The Design Intern will perform the following:

- Work with the Lead of Student Supports to plan and coordinate design activities for the creation of student-driven, experiential learning templates;
- Assist with the formulation of design methodologies for a series of design sessions;
- Assist with stakeholder recruitment;
- Provide training support for students;
- Assist with an evaluation process for template adoption in colleges and universities;
- Collect and manage design research and evaluation data;
- Support communications planning and media production for lab activities;
- Support activities to develop, promote and advance the lab and eCampusOntario.

Requirements:

- Diploma, Bachelor's Degree or close to completion.
- Experience with multiple design processes, methods and tools, such as strategic, service, curricula and media design.
- Able to handle multiple tasks and shifting demands.
- Be open to ambiguity and frequent change to project components.
- Excellent writing skills across fields: academic, technical, online, social media, etc.
- Capable of communicating to diverse audiences: students, academics and industry.
- Some formal education in design is preferred.
